



CHOICE OF CATEGORY: REGULARITY OR TOURING?

In both categories, the Road Book is drawn up in a clear and precise way: metered 'Tulip - Arrow', with very little non-metered route. 2 easy-to-read maps for the REGULARITY category. No road maps for the TOURING category.



1/ REGULARITY : The category that puts the crew's driving and navigation skills to the test. Nearly 15 Regularity Tests (RT), specifically calibrated for PRE WAR cars over 3 days of rallying, are on the programme. To add variety, there are also 1 or 2 RT's with easy-to-read maps. Average speeds range from 30 to 45 km/h maximum.

2/ TOURING :

No rankings or time checks. The road book will be exclusively in Metric arrows with clear indications and road signs. Distance measuring devices are recommended but not necessary. Starts are given after the REGULARITY categories. A special prize will be awarded to the most beautiful TOURING car at the end of the rally.
