# **3 - Event description**

**3.1** Sierra Nevada Classic is a regularity event for historic cars. The route is to be navigated and an average speed of 50 kmh per hour or below is to be observed. This event takes place on open roads and belongs to the regularity « ballade » for historic cars and therefore it is not a speed competition Time controls exist to check that competitors respect open road regulations and local regulations.

There's no time check (TC). Competitors start each stage whenever they want and they arrive whenever they want. (Free start system).

**3.2** The road book will only use precise metric Tulip arrows to indicate, or non-metric Tulip arrow, no maps.

**3.3** Category Choice:

- '**<u>Touring</u>**: Touring rally, at your own pace, no time pressure.

- **<u>'Challenger</u>**: A regularity route that is truly calibrated for relaxed competition and also accessible to novice crews.

- **<u>'Regularity</u>**: The 'queen category', with almost 30 regularity tests over the 5 days of the rally.

### 4 - Team – Competitors

**4.1** One team will be made of 2 persons minimum indicated on the official list of competitors during the whole event.

**4.2** The entire team must be on board the car during the whole event except when the car is stopped at a time control, in case of emergency or on a marshal's request.

**4.3** During the whole event, the team must respect the legal obligations about traffic regulations.

**4.4** During the whole event, it is forbidden:

- to transport, or carry or pull any competitor's vehicle with another vehicle .

- to block intentionally other competitors .

- to behave using incompatible manners with fair-play .

**4.5** Documents to be available in the car at any time are: registration card showing the exact address of the owner and valid insurance document.

**4.6** A crew that is about to be overtaken must give way as soon as the road profile allows. The overtaking team must do so in compliance with the specific conditions of the route Code and taking into account the specific conditions of the terrain.

### 5 - Vehicle admission

**5.1** Number of cars admited to start will be 60 for all categories.

**5.2** "REGULARITY" and "CHALLENGER" category will be available for cars build before 31/12/1984

**5.3** Organization staff reserves 10 places for pre-1950 cars.

**5.4** Organization staff has the right to refuse car's entry form without being obliged to give any reasons. In that case, a total refund will be made.

**5.5** The information concerning the year and type of vehicle on the car registration document will be included on the official document for the event.

**5.6** "REGULARITY" and "CHALLENGER" category will be divided in the following classes :

Classe 1 : before 31 december 1950

- Classe 2 : From January 1st 1951 to December 31- 1960
- Classe 3 : From January 1st 1961 to December 31- 1968
- Classe 4 : From January 1st 1969 to December 31- 1984

The organizing committee reserves the right to accept some vehicles built after 1984, (5 vehicles maximum).

- **5.7** Start will be refused to any car that :
  - does not belong to the original condition.
  - is in a restoration process or badly rusted
  - is not in order with the present regulations

### 6 – Technical rules

**6.1** All cars must be in accordance with their own countries regulations, as well as the technical rules of this regulation

**6.2** The pre-event technical control will specifically check the security items; legal matters, appearance and authenticity.

**6.3** Devices used to measure distance (Brantz, halda, tripmaster, retrotrip) may have a mechanical screen or LCD, LED screen.

**6.4** Participants may not use electrical or electronic equipment to communicate with the outside as an aid during the event, except in cases of force majeure (computer, mobile phone).

**6.5** Any computerized programmable system connected (or not) to the car is forbidden. Blunik, Chrysartec, Chronopist system is strictly forbidden. In case this kind of device is found in the car: participant must remove it or application of a 1000 points penalty

**6.6** All road books will be given to all teams the same day.

### 7 - Application's expenses

**7.1** Any competitor who wishes to apply to this event must send back the application form (available as well on our website <u>www.SeaSunRally.com</u>) In order to be registered, the amount of **800 euro** should be paid. Balance should be paid latest 30-06-2025.

As the number of competitors is limited to 60, pre-entry forms will be primarily accepted.

**7.2** The financial contribution for two people and one car in an all-inclusive 5-star hotel is **5540** euros for the "REGULARITY" or "CHALLENGER" category and **5280** euros for the "TOURING" category (no time check).

The financial contribution for two people and a car in an all-inclusive 3-star hotel is **4350** euros for all categories.

- **7.3** Application fee for one team (2 persons- 1 car) includes:
  - 5 days rallying
  - All hotels nights from Sept. 21 to Sept. 26
  - All breakfasts, lunches & dinners
  - compulsory competition insurance by the organiser (1)
  - road-book set
  - road booklet
  - rally plates
  - door numbers
  - trophies and souvenirs
  - luggage service
  - mechanic service
  - rescue trailer
  - other useful documents

(1) this insurance includes compulsory civil responsibility for car and 2 people on board and legal assistance during the whole event . Damages between competitors are not covered.

Europ Assistance, Mondial Assist. or similar Assist. is compulsory for every competitor.

7.5 Entry fee will be refunded 80% if the competitors decline with a proper postal letter before 1<sup>st</sup> June 2025. After this date no more refunds will be made, however special cases will be considered by the organization and a 50 % refund might be made.

## 8 - Event description

### 8.1 Start

Competition numbers will be given in order of the application's reception and fee's payment with priority for the oldest cars and pre-entry applications - start will be given minute by minute

- official time of the event is the Tripy system time

### 8.2 Speed control

Speed control: speed checks can be organized throughout the route, mainly in the agglomerations, at the limited speed zones mentioned in the road-book. These controls may be carried out by the organizing committee or the police. 30 % overspeeding : official warning by the clerk of the course more than 30 % : automatic penalties increasing following the overspeeding level.

#### 8.3 Regularity test

Tripy satellite system allows the rally organisation to check that every participant follows the correct route and respects the average speed in accordance with the local traffic road regulations.

For each Regularity Test, participants will receive an average speed in KM per hour. Participants should try to respect this average speed until the end of the test. There might be several time check on this leg.

Regularity Test's finish will be indicated in the Road Book.

### 9 - Start areas, regroup areas and finish areas

The organization decline any responsibilities for damages to the cars parked at the start areas, the regroup areas or the finish areas even if they are guarded by any security officer or marshal.

# 10 - Services and Petrol refueling

Petrol refuelling areas will be mentioned in the road-book.

# 11 - Additional regulations - Interpretations

**11.1** Any possible modifications or additional rules to this event will be announced by numbered and dated pages that will automatically be included in this regulation.

**11.2** In case of different interpretations, the text written in French language will be the reference for law applications.

**11.3** Written briefings <u>and</u> oral briefings are automatically included in the regulations.

# 12 - Documents controls

**12.1** « Notice to attend » letter will indicate when and where the documents controls and scrutineering will be done.

**12.2** At the documents control competitors will put their signature on a resort's abandonment document.

**12.3** The driver must be in possession of his valid driving license.

Driver and navigator must be in possession of: « notice to attend » letter, ID or passport, a legal authorization allowing to drive the car if neither the driver or navigator is the owner of the car.

# 13 – Technical control - Scrutineering

 $\label{eq:13.1} \textbf{(Notice to attend)} \ \text{letter will indicate when and where the technical control will be done.}$ 

**13.2** Rally identification's plates and organization advertisement must be put on the car at the indicated spots before technical control.

**13.3** All matters of the 6 th paragraph may be properly checked.

**14 – Chronometer system:** The time checks will be taken by the TRIPY system.

# 15 - Penalties

### **15.1** Forbidden Start

- 1. Vehicle not meeting technical or administrative rules
- 2. non payment of the complete fees

#### 15.2 Exclusion

- 1. Intentionally block the way for other competitors. Behave in a manner incompatible with fair play.
- 2. dangerous driving
- 3. impoliteness or threat towards a marshal.
- 4. over speeding noticed by a marshal.
- 5. Non compliance with article 6.5

### **15.3** Penalties

1. Unrealized stage	1800 pts
2. passage control missing	120 pts
3. regularity test missing	450 pts
4. maximum penalties on regularity	450 pts
5. maximum fixed penalty by taking time to late regularity test after	
calculation of the age-coefficient	60 pts
6. per minute in advance on stage	120 pts
7. for each time missed in a regularity stage	60 pts
8. fixed penalty for the presence of a prohibited device1000 pts	

#### 15.4 Age-coefficient:

(\*)Penalties for being late will be modified by an age-coefficient calculation, very old cars will have less penalties than more recent ones: **Example :** a BMW 328 (1939) = 39 pts, a BMW 2002 (1972) = 72 pts.

### **15.5 JOKER**

All RT finish time checks will be taken into account for the ranking, with the exception of two Jokers per half-day up to a limit of 60 points per Joker, only in the event of late arrival. (in case of being late because of truck, bus or tractor)

### 16 – Complaints and appeal

**16.1** Only the individual and written complaints will be acceptable.

**16.2** Any complaint, concerning the stage, must be given to the event director at the latest half an hour after competitor's arrival.

**16.3** Any complaint, concerning classification's results, must be given to the event director at the latest - half an hour after stage's results have been posted up.

### 17 - Classifications

**17.1** Several classifications will be posted up at the end of the event, rewarding competitors:

- overall classification REGULARITY
- overall classification CHALLENGER
- classes classification REGULARITY + CHALLENGER

**17.2** In case of ex-aequo, the weakest cubic capacity of car's engine will be the winner and after, if still ex-aequo, the oldest car will be the winner.
